The Event

Unlike the average autocross, our track will be more open and thus, speeds will be higher – much like a road course. The expected highest speed of an average car on the course will be approximately 110 Km/h. The track will incorporate various corners, braking areas, and straight-aways.

The Schedule

8:15 AM - 8:30 AM: *Vehicle Roll In/Tech Inspection*

8:30 AM – 9:00 AM: *Drivers Meeting/Track walk*

9:00 AM – 4:15 PM: *Hotlapping event*

4:15 PM – 5:00 PM: *Area clean up*

5:00 PM: *All Vehicles MUST be off the base*

Racing Cost

Driver registration will be limited to 20 cars per event to keep the number of laps at a maximum. It will be based on a first come first serve basis UNLESS you have prepaid before the day of the event.

The above price will include lunches and a drink for the driver.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST PRE-REGISTER. For security reasons, you will not be allowed on the base unless you pre-register.

The Requirements/Rules

All vehicles to be raced must meet the following requirements:

- All vehicles must be equipped with a metal battery tie down bar, must be in reasonably good mechanical condition and must not be leaking excessive fluids.
- No vehicles with a high center of gravity, such as SUVs, Trucks, Vans and the like will be allowed to hotlap the track.
- All drivers and spectators MUST sign a waiver prior to entering the tarmac areas releasing the NECC from liability as a result of any incident that occurs at the hotlap event. Drivers and spectators unwilling to sign this waiver will not be allowed to enter the event, but will have their prepaid money refunded without penalty.
- Spectators are requested to stay away from the track while it is being used.
- Drivers must be wearing a Snell 95, 2000 or 2005 (M or SA) approved helmet at all times while on the track. You may be able to borrow a helmet from someone participating. A helmet that is only DOT certified will not do.
- All participants must take shifts in watching race traffic (marshalling), and replacing cones once disturbed. More details to be discussed on the day of.
- All participants under the age of 18 must have the Parental Consent Waiver filled out by both parents/guardians, as well as the Minor Consent Waiver filled out. Please email admin@n-e-c-c.com for these forms.
- DO NOT SPEED ON THE BASE. The Military Police can and will ticket any cars found traveling over the posted speed limit – 40km/h in most places. The MP's also reserve the right to kick you off the base for speeding – don't do it!
- No racing outside the hotlap track area – anyone caught racing anywhere on the base will be immediately excluded from the event, this includes and tarmac area outside the track.
- Make sure you SIGN IN when you first enter the base, and sign OUT as you leave the base – again, please respect the base personnel.

In order to be registered for our events, you will need to submit the following information:

- Whether you are registering as a hotlap driver or a spectator
- Last Name, First Name
- Vehicle year, make, and model
- Vehicle VIN #
- License plate #
- Your Driver's license #
- The names of any and all spectators that may attend the event with you (Last Name, First name, and all vehicle info as the driver)
- Your home telephone number
- Your email address

Entering the base:

- Upon turning off 97th Street, proceed to the first gate. Have ID ready for all occupants of the vehicle. Tell the guard you are there for the NECC Hotlap event.
- When you are cleared to proceed, drive up Churchill Street, and take a LEFT at the stop sign (Head North).
- Proceed until you reach another stop sign. Turn RIGHT onto Vimy Street.
- Proceed down Vimy Street until you reach a large chain link gate and booth. Park your vehicle – you and your passengers MUST check in with the guard in the small building on the right side of the gate.
- Then you must check-in with the NECC Staff awaiting you. All drivers and spectators must complete the waiver forms, and register. All drivers not already prepaid, may do so at that time.
- When check-in is complete, proceed through the gate onto the runway.
- Vehicles taking part in the event can proceed to the end of the runway to begin technical inspection.
- Spectator vehicles can be parked along the edge of the runway, to your right.
