Driver registration will be limited to 20 cars per event to keep the number of laps at a maximum. It will be based on a first come first serve basis UNLESS you have prepaid before the day of the event.

The Requirements/Rules

All vehicles to be raced must meet the following requirements:

- All vehicles must be equipped with a metal battery tie down bar, must be in reasonably good mechanical condition and must not be leaking excessive fluids.
- No vehicles with a high center of gravity, such as SUVs, Trucks, Vans and the like will be allowed to hot lap the track.
- All drivers and spectators MUST sign a waiver prior to entering the tarmac areas releasing the NECC from liability as a result of any incident that occurs at the hot lap event. Drivers and spectators unwilling to sign this waiver will not be allowed to enter the event, but will have their prepaid money refunded without penalty.
- Spectators are requested to stay away from the track while it is being used.
- Drivers must be wearing a Snell 95, 2000 or 2005 (M or SA) approved helmet at all times while on the track. You may be able to borrow a helmet from someone participating. A helmet that is only DOT certified will not do.
- All participants must take shifts in watching race traffic (marshalling), and replacing cones once disturbed. More details to be discussed on the day of.



- All participants under the age of 18 must have the Parental Consent Waiver filled out by both parents/guardians, as well as the Minor Consent Waiver filled out. Please email admin@n-e-c-c.com for these forms.
- DO NOT SPEED ON THE BASE. The Military Police can and will ticket any cars found traveling over the posted speed limit – 40km/h in most places. The MP's also reserve the right to kick you off the base for speeding – don't do it!
- No racing outside the hot lap track area – anyone caught racing anywhere on the base will be immediately excluded from the event, this includes and tarmac area outside the track.
- Convertibles, cabriolets, and open-top cars by any other name are permitted if they are equipped with appropriate rollover protection located behind both driver and passenger. Appropriate types of rollover protection include fixed roll bars, fixed roll cages, and roll bars that deploy automatically in the event of a collision or rollover
- A helmet and factory-installed lap and shoulder belts are mandatory. A standard Snell 2005 or later rated motorcycle helmet is acceptable.
